# The Posture Required for Prophetic Study

We are not here to create enemies; we are trying to understand the times. Studying cultural shifts requires holding two tensions together simultaneously.

Compassion

## Compromise

Affirms what God never approved; comforts people into deception.

## The Jesus Model

Speaking clearly while remembering every person is made in the image of God.

## Apathy

Total disengagement.

## Harshness

Wounds people instead of healing.

# The Cultural Shift: From Ignoring to Resisting

Jesus specifically highlighted two historical eras as blueprints for the future. The critical difference between them is how they engaged with Truth.

The Era	The Society's Stance on Truth	The Result
The Days of Noah	Ignored it. Distracted by everyday life.	Caught completely unaware.
The Days of Lot	Resisted it. Redefined morality based on feeling.	Demanded cultural agreement; Truth became offensive.

**Key Insight:** In Lot's day, people didn't just want tolerance—they demanded a world where Truth could no longer judge them.

# Societal Decay Can Look Highly Functional

Sodom's greatest deception was not its immorality; it was its functionality. A society can be fully operational and completely condemned at the same time.

**Luke 17:28:** Eating, drinking, buying, selling, planting, building. The markets worked. The tech advanced. Life felt normal.

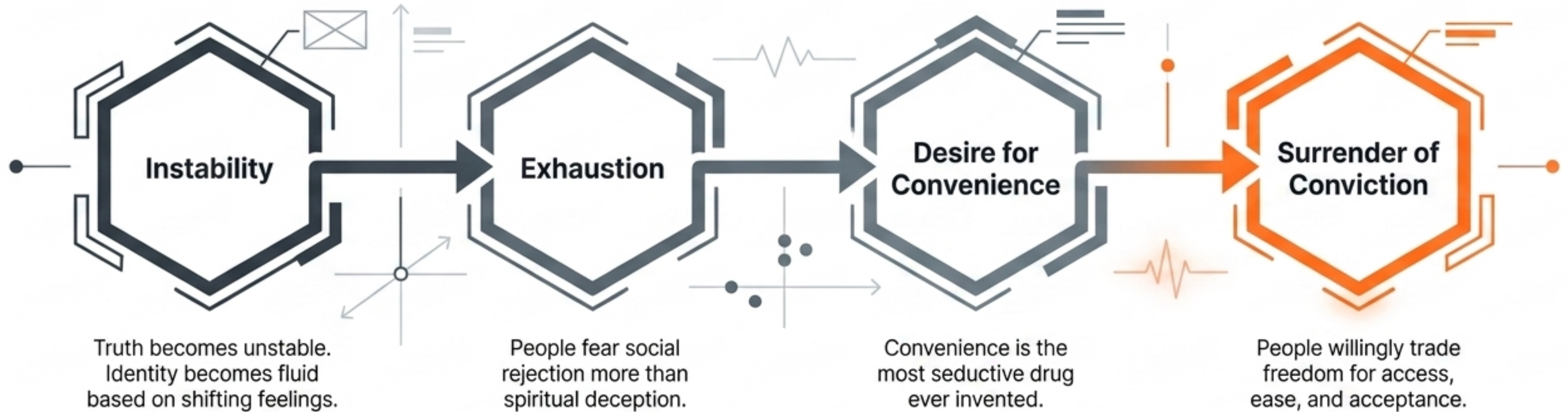
**Ezekiel 16:49:** Arrogant, overfed, unconcerned, did not help the poor. Loss of restraint. Morally numb.

You can upgrade your systems without upgrading your soul. Normalcy creates a dangerous illusion of safety.



# The Architecture of Compliance

A future global system cannot function unless people are already conditioned to surrender conviction. **Force is secondary; the primary driver is convenience.**



**Deception captures the mind long before control captures the hand.**

# The Red Horse: An Environment of Exhaustion

The second seal is broken, releasing the Red Horse. Its primary function is not just to bring war, but to actively remove peace from the earth.

**Continuous Global Agitation:**  
Wars and rumors of wars.  
Tension everywhere.

**Nervous System Overload:**  
Humans are not designed for constant alert. The brain rewires for survival, not rest.

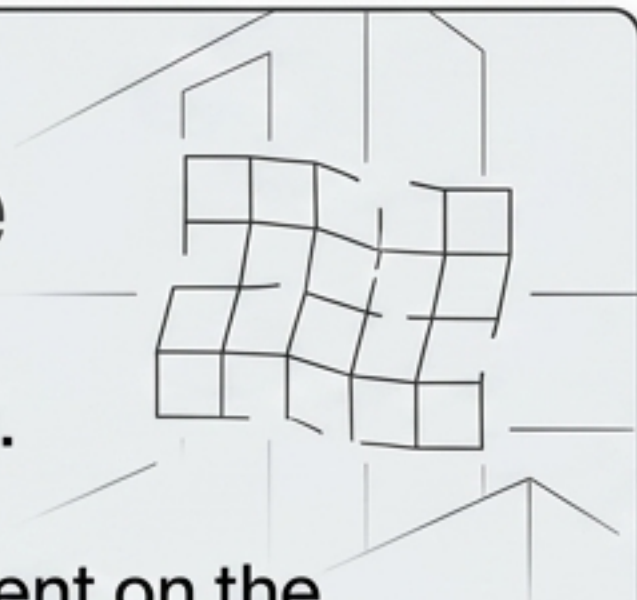
**The Vulnerability:**

# Two Models of Peace

## Worldly Peace

- **Nature:** Circumstantial.
- **Requirement:** Dependent on the environment. Threats must be absent. Money must be right.
- **Result:** Fragile. Collapses when the system shakes.



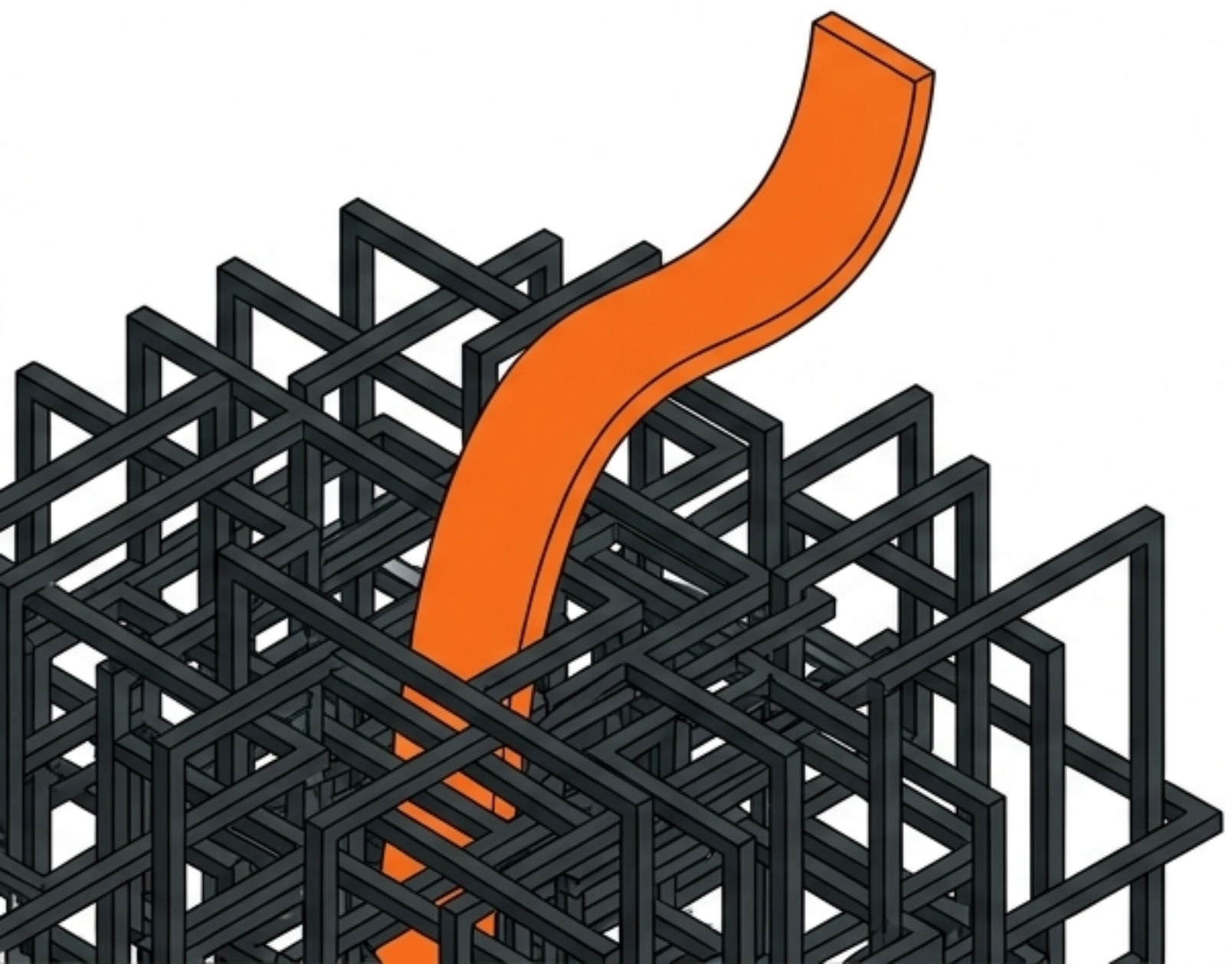
## Jesus' Peace

- **Nature:** Internal and Supernatural.
- **Requirement:** Dependent entirely on His Presence.
- **Result:** Robust. Thrives in the middle of the storm. You do not need the world to be calm for you to be calm.



# A Rescue Plan Written in Advance

The Bible is the only book that diagnoses this law and offers the way out.
